**Regent Serviceberry**

Amelanchier alnifolia Regent

Sun to Part Shade

4-6' tall 4-6' across

A nicely shaped shrub form of serviceberry with large white flowers in spring. The fruit forms in mid-summer, is dark purple to black, sweet, and good for eating and making jelly.

---

**Viking Chokeberry**

Aronia melanocarpa 'Viking'

Sun to Part Shade

4-6' tall 3-5' across

An attractive plant with white flowers in spring and large glossy green foliage that turns red and orange in the fall. It produces large clusters of black fruit high in vitamins. Easily grown.

---

**Helmond Pillar Barberrry**

Berberis thunbergii

Sun

4-5' tall 1-2' across

A multi-stemmed upright columnar growing barberry with dark red-purple foliage. Tiny white flowers in spring and shiny red berries in the fall. Great for a narrow hedge or small screen.

---

**Ruby Carousel Barberrry**

Berberis thunbergii 'Bailone'

Sun

3-4' tall 3-4' across

A low, rounded, red leafed barberry with excellent uniformity. A great choice for hedges or foundation plantings.

---

**Concord Barberrry**

Berberis thunbergii 'Concord'

Sun

2' tall 2' across

A dwarf ball shape with velvety deep purple foliage. A great choice for hedges or foundation plantings. A rust free barberry. This is a beauty!

---

**Crimson Pygmy Barberrry**

Berberis thunbergii 'Crimson Pygmy'

Sun

2' tall 2-3' across

Dense low spreading compact form and dark burgundy foliage. Excellent accent plant for foundation plantings or low barrier hedge.

---

**Gold Nugget Barberrry**

Berberis thunbergii 'Gold Nugget'

Sun

12-18" tall 18-24" across

Bright lemon yellow foliage all season long. Excellent accent plant for foundation plantings or low barrier hedge.

---

**Rosy Glow Barberrry**

Berberis thunbergii 'Rosy Glow'

Sun

4-5' tall 4-5' across

Colorful rose and pink mottled foliage that matures to a deep purple. Outstanding accent plant for foundation plantings or hedges.

---

**Winter Gem Boxwood**

Buxus microphylla asiaticum 'Winter Gem'

Shade

3' tall 3' across

Dark green oval-shaped leaves with compact growth habit. Excellent variety for small hedges. Plant in a protected area, best on N or E side of a structure.

---

---

**Blauer Heinz Boxwood**

Buxus sempervirens 'Blauer Heinz'

Shade to Part Shade

12-24" tall 1-2' across

Dwarf variety with glaucous blue-green foliage is ideal as hardy edging or mixing with flower borders. Needs little maintenance.

---

**Graham Blandy Boxwood**

Buxus sempervirens 'Graham Blandy'

Part Sun to Shade

6-9' tall 3-5' across

This English boxwood has a fantastic dense columnar form that contrasts well with any planting arrangement and also creates a fine hedge.

---

**Chicagoland Green Boxwood**

Buxus X 'Chicagoland Green'

Shade to Part Shade

3-4' tall 4-5' across

A fine textured evergreen that tolerates pruning and shearing. Often used as a small hedge. Has excellent cold hardiness.

---

**Green Mountain Boxwood**

Buxus x 'Green Mountain'

Shade

5' tall 3' across

A natural cone-shaped shrub with bright green summer color which softens to a golden winter color. Plant in a protected area, best on the N or E side of a structure.

---

**Texas Scarlet Quince**

Chaenomeles speciosa 'Texas Scarlet'

Sun to Part Shade

2-3' tall 3-4' across

Low spreading shrub with fiery scarlet blossoms in April and glossy foliage in summer. Provides excellent early spring color in the landscape. Prune after flowering. Useful as a hedge.

**Soft Serve False Cypress**

Chamaecyparis pisifera 'Dow Whiting' PP20883

Sun to Part Shade

6-10' tall 3-6' across

A compact conical Chamaecyparis with graceful soft fern-like branching. The leaves are bright green on top and flecked with silver-blue on the underside.

---

**Gold Mops False Cypress**

Chamaecyparis pisifera 'Gold Mops'

Sun to Part Sun

4-6' tall 4-6' across

Yellow scale-like foliage covers the thin pendulous stems. Relatively low, semi-weeping habit. The golden-yellow color stays that way if the plant is sited in full sun.

**Ivory Halo Variegated Dogwood**

Cornus Alba

Part Shade

5-6' tall 4-6' across

Noted for its compact size, variegated leaves, and bright red twigs in winter. Very showy against a snowy backdrop.

---

**Baton Rouge Dogwood**

Cornus alba 'Minbat'

Sun to Part Shade

3-4' tall 3-4' across

This plant offers white flowers in spring, followed by white berries that attract birds in summer. Medium green foliage transforms to a brilliant reddish purple in fall. Bright red stems in winter.

**Harry Lauder's Walkingstick**

*Corylus americana* 'Contorta'

Sun to Part Sun

6-8' tall 4-6' across

A plant that is known for its unusual growth habit. The branches are highly contorted giving the plant a gnarled twisted appearance. Makes a great accent plant. Branches are valued in floral designs.

**Royal Purple Smokebush**

*Cotinus coggyria* 'Royal Purple'

Sun

8-10' tall 8-10' across

Large shrub or small tree with brilliant purple colored foliage that keeps its color all season long. Large, beige, feathery plumes appear in midsummer which gives the plant a smokey appearance.

---

**Cranberry Cotoneaster**

*Cotoneaster apiculatus*

Sun to Part Shade

2-3' tall 3-6' across

A graceful low spreading shrub with glossy leaves, pink flowers, and bright red berries. Slow growth rate. Excellent for bank plantings.

---

**Compact Burning Bush**

*Euonymus alatus* 'Compacta'

Sun to Part Shade

5-8' tall 5-8' across

A dense, twiggy, flat-topped, mounded shrub with dark green leaves that turn a brilliant rose-red in fall. Compact branching does not mean dwarf by any means. Responds well to pruning.

**Rudy Haag Burning Bush**

*Euonymus alatus* 'Rudy Haag'

Sun to Part Shade

3-5' tall 3-5' across

A true dwarf, an extremely slow-growing burning bush with consistent red fall color. Use this plant in situations where regular burning bush get too large.

---

**Emerald Gaiety Euonymus**

*Euonymus fortunei* 'Emerald Gaiety'

Shade

12-24" tall 2-3' across

Green and cream evergreen foliage that turns pinkish-red in winter. Low growing, irregular habit, may climb or sprawl. Protect from afternoon sun and wind. Great as a foundation accent plant.

---

**Emerald and Gold Euonymus**

*Euonymus fortunei* 'Emerald n' Gold'

Shade

12-24" tall 2-3' across

Bright green and gold evergreen foliage that turns pink-red in winter. Low growing, irregular habit, may climb or sprawl. Protect from afternoon sun and wind. Great foundation or accent plant.

**Gold Splash Euonymus**

*Euonymus fortunei* 'Gold Splash'

Part Shade to Part Sun

12-18" tall 12-18" across

A low growing *Euonymus* with big round leaves displaying a wide deep golden-yellow edge. Yellow fruit and orange seeds are beautiful and persistent.

**Sunspot Euonymus**

*Euonymus fortunei* 'Sunspot'

Sun to Shade

3' tall 3' across

Leaves are glossy green with bright golden-yellow centers. Spreading mounding growth habit. Protect from afternoon sun and wind. Great as a foundation or accent plant.

---

**Pauli Euonymus**

*Euonymus kiautschovica* 'Pauli'

Sun to Shade

5-6' tall 5-6' across

Glossy dark-green foliage. Vigorous grower tolerating a wide range of conditions. Nice shrub for hedges. May retain some brownish leaves thru the winter months.

---

**Lynwood Gold Forsythia**

*Forsythia x intermedia* 'Lynwood'

Sun

6-8' tall 8-10' across

An old time favorite with an upright spreading habit and big yellow flowers up the entire length of stems. Flowers appear before leaves emerge. Prune after flowering. Useful as a hedge.

**Witch Hazel**

*Hamamelis virginiana*

Sun to Part Sun

12-15' tall 12-15' across

Flowers have fragrant, yellow, ribbon-like petals, 1.5" in diameter and bloom in late fall about the time leaves drop. Does well in woods shade and naturalized areas. Good shrub border or screen plant

---

**Bluebird Rose of Sharon**

*Hibiscus syriacus*

Sun to Part Shade

8-10' tall 6-8' across

A large, upright shrub featuring magnificent blue flowers with purple throats. Flowering in mid-summer.

---

**Aphrodite Rose of Sharon**

*Hibiscus syriacus* 'Aphrodite'

Sun to Part Shade

8-12' tall 6-10' across

Dark hollyhock-like rosy-pink flowers with deeper red eyes from late summer until mid-fall. Very adaptable, hardy shrub with upright form.

---

**Sanchoyo Rose of Sharon**

*Hibiscus syriacus* 'Sanchoyo'

Sun to Part Shade

8-12' tall 6-10' across

A new variety of Rose of Sharon found in Korea. A stand out plant with rich deep pink flowers from late summer until mid-fall. Very adaptable, hardy shrub with upright form.

---

**Annabelle Hydrangea**

*Hydrangea arborescens* 'Annabelle'

Shade

4-5' tall 3-5' across

A stunning white hydrangea, often producing blossoms over 10" in diameter. The huge white blooms appear in profusion without fail every year, even after intensely cold winters or heavy pruning.

**Variegated Hydrangea**

Hydrangea macrophylla

Shade

3-4' tall 3-4' across

An elegant lacecap Hydrangea with striking green and white variegated leaves. The flowers have a pure white outer ring with the center of the flowers blue or pink depending on the soil pH.

---

**Endless Summer The Original Hydrangea**

Hydrangea macrophylla 'Bailmer' PP15298

Part Shade

3-4' tall 3-4' across

A small shrub that produces large flowers all summer long. The flowers are pink if planted in alkaline soil and blue in acidic soil. Removing old flowers will stimulate rebloom.

---

**Penny Mac Hydrangea**

Hydrangea macrophylla 'Penny Mac'

Part Shade

3-4' tall 3-4' across

A very hardy blue flowering Hydrangea. Will bloom on new wood. May need to add aluminum sulphate to acidify soil.

---

**Endless Summer BloomStruck Hydrangea**

Hydrangea macrophylla 'PIIHM-II' PP25566

Shade to Part Sun

3-4' tall 4-5' across

This new plant will reliably produce large mophead flowers of pink or blue depending on the soil pH. Fall leaf color is a lovely reddish-purple.

---

**Pink Diamond Hydrangea**

Hydrangea paniculata 'Pink Diamond'

Sun to Shade

8-10' tall 8-10' across

Extremely large white florets emerge in July and transform to a rich pink that matures to a beautiful rose-purple. Flowers are held distinctly upright. Prune heavily in early spring. Good as hedge.

---

**Fire Light Hydrangea**

Hydrangea paniculata 'SMHPFL' PP25135

Sun to Part Shade

4-5' tall 4-5' across

A hardy Hydrangea producing upright panicles packed with florets that transform from white to pink and finish a rich red. Thick sturdy stems present well.

---

**Oakleaf Hydrangea**

Hydrangea quercifolia

Part Shade

4-6' tall 4-6' across

Large, leathery, oak-shaped leaves develop spectacular fall colors ranging from wine-red to purple to burgundy. July blooms go through a color transformation from white to pink to creamy-bronze.

---

**Ruby Slippers Hydrangea**

Hydrangea quercifolia 'Ruby Slippers'

Sun to Part Shade

3-4' tall 4-5' across

White summer flowers quickly turn pale pink, then deepen to rose and may reach 9 inches in length. Mahogany-red fall color.

---

---

**Starburst Hypericum**

Hypericum frondosum 'Starburst'

Sun to Part Shade

2-3' tall 3-4' across

A very hardy shrub with bluish-green foliage. Bright yellow flowers that appear to be miniature starburst cover the plant in June. Makes a lovely facer plant or hedge.

---

**Shamrock Holly**

Ilex glabra 'Shamrock'

Sun to Part Shade

3-4' tall 3-4' across

An excellent evergreen with a compact habit and slender foliage. This holly will grow in most soils and is extremely hardy. The plant is slow growing and has a nice rounded form for accents or hedges.

---

**China Holly**

Ilex x merserve

Part Shade

6-8' tall 6-8' across

A fast-growing holly with exceptional berry set. It has dense rounded growth and shears well. Has better heat resistance than most blue hollies. A male and female have been planted together.

---

**Henry's Garnet Sweetspire**

Itea virginica 'Henry's Garnet'

Sun to Part Shade

3-5' tall 4-6' across

Fragrant white flowers in June and July. Prefers moist, fertile soils. Foliage changes to a scarlet crimson in the fall. Tolerates wet locations.

---

**Compact Pfitzer Juniper**

Juniperus chinensis 'Compact Pfitzer'

Sun

3-4' tall 6' across

Bright green foliage, vigorous compact grower. Good for foundation plantings and low barriers or hedges.

---

**Mint Julep Juniper**

Juniperus chinensis 'Mint Julep'

Sun

4' tall 4' across

Bright mint-green foliage. Fast grower with vase-shaped habit. Good for foundation plantings and low barriers or hedges.

---

**Saybrook Gold Juniper**

Juniperus chinensis 'Saybrook Gold'

Sun

2-3' tall 4-5' across

The brightest low spreading gold juniper on the market. The bright color is maintained through all seasons and ideal for foundation or mass plantings. Does best in full sun and well-drained soil.

---

**Blue Chip Juniper**

Juniperus horizontalis 'Blue Chip'

Sun

8-10" tall 8' across

Soft silver-blue foliage that changes to purple in winter. Its attractive feathered branching makes it an excellent groundcover or facer plant.

---

---

**Blue Rug Juniper**

Juniperus horizontalis 'Blue Rug'

Sun

3-4" tall 6-8' across

Low trailing juniper with an intense blue foliage. Excellent as a ground cover or for bank plantings.

---

**Prince Of Wales Juniper**

Juniperus horizontalis 'Prince of Wales'

Sun

6" tall 4' across

Soft bright green foliage that turns a purplish-brown in winter. Grows in starburst pattern from center. Excellent as a ground cover or for bank plantings.

---

**Calgary Carpet Juniper**

Juniperus sabina 'Calgary Carpet'

Sun

12" tall 4-5' across

A hardy low spreading Juniper with soft bright green foliage. Performs best as low growing accent plant or mass plantings.

---

**Golden Vicary Privet**

Ligustrum x vicaryi

Sun

6-8' tall 5-6' across

Compact shrub with waxy, bright yellow leaves. Produces white flowers in June, and black berries in September, when not pruned. Tolerant of heavy pruning, and excellent for hedges.

---

**Honeybush Honeysuckle**

Lonicera periclymenum

Sun

2' tall 4' across

Sprays of old fashioned honeysuckle flowers of red and cream adorn this plant from June-August. Produces a wonderful fragrance. Groundcover form of our native climber.

---

**Oregon Grapeholly**

Mahonia aquifolium

Part Shade

4-6' tall 4-6' across

Stiff erect stems and leathery foliage. Golden blossoms in spring followed by blue-black berries. Excellent accent plant for foundation plantings. Prefers a location protected from winter winds.

---

**Festivus Gold Ninebark**

Physocarpus opulifolius 'Bert Dart's G' PP26246

Sun

3-4' tall 3-4' across

An improved dwarf Ninebark with bright gold foliage. It maintains its yellow coloration throughout the season and is great in the landscape. Drought tolerant and very adaptable.

---

**Diabolo Ninebark**

Physocarpus opulifolius 'Diabolo'

Sun to Part Shade

8-10' tall 8-10' across

A large rounded shrub with beautiful red-purple foliage on long arching canes. Blooms in spring with creamy-white flowers that contrast with the dark foliage. Drought tolerant.

---

**Little Devil Ninebark**

Physocarpus opulifolius 'Donna May' PP22634

Sun to Part Shade

3-4' tall 3-4' across

A new compact Ninebark with deep burgundy foliage. Will make a wonderful accent in any garden with its dark foliage and white flowers in June. An easy care plant that needs little attention.

---

**Amber Jubilee Ninebark**

Physocarpus opulifolius 'Jefam' PP23177

Sun

5-6' tall 3-4' across

A new plant selection with striking foliage in glowing tones of orange, yellow, and gold. Rounded and dense in habit, delicate white blooms in spring, red and purple fall foliage.

---

**Weeping Norway Spruce**

Picea

Part Sun to Sun

6' Tall 10' Across

A slow growing plant with trailing branches. Can be staked or trained to desired shape or height. Year-round interest for borders or rock gardens.

---

**Dwarf Alberta Spruce**

Picea glauca 'Conica'

Sun to Part Shade

5-7' tall 4' across

Dwarf evergreen with fine textured, bluish-gray needles. Good foundation accent plant. A very slow growth rate. Tolerates wind, heat, cold and drought. Prefers moist well-drained soil.

---

**Globe Blue Spruce**

Picea pungens 'Glauca Globosa'

Sun

3' tall 4-5' across

Compact mound shaped shrub with beautiful blue foliage. Valuable as an accent or specimen. Very Slow Growth Rate.

---

**Dwarf Mugho Pine**

Pinus mugho var. 'Pumilio'

Sun

3-4' tall 3-5' across

Slow growing mound-forming pine with rich green needles. Excellent as a specimen plant. Tight compact form may be maintained by shearing new growth in early spring.

---

**Dwarf Flowering Almond**

Prunus glandulosa

Sun to Part Shade

4-5' tall 3-4' across

Memories of Grandma flood back with this old time favorite. Double pink flowers line the stems in early spring. Followed by bright green, shiny foliage. Very showy when in bloom. Useful as hedge.

---

**Purpleleaf Sandcherry**

Prunus x cistena

Sun to Part Shade

6-8' tall 5-8' across

Upright shrub producing small pale pink blossoms in spring and deep burgundy summer foliage. Excellent accent plant for foundation, border plantings or hedges.

---

**Lowboy Pyracantha**

Pyracantha coccinea 'Lowboy'

Sun to Shade

3-4' tall 5-6' across

A dwarf low spreading shrub with dark-green foliage. White flowers produced in spring followed by orange berries in fall. Good disease resistance. Good hedge or barrier plant.

---

**PJM Rhododendron**

Rhododendron 'PJM'

Shade

3-5' tall 3-5' across

Bright lavender flowers in spring. Small dark green foliage that turns plum purple in fall. Requires soil to be amended with aluminum sulfate and peat moss. Plant on N or E side of a structure.

---

**Gro Low Sumac**

Rhus aromatica 'Gro Low'

Sun to Part Shade

2-3' tall 6-8' across

A low spreader with glossy green foliage, good flower and fruit production, and superb orange-red fall color. A low maintenance groundcover. Great for tough areas. Tolerates dry soils.

---

**Tiger Eyes Staghorn Sumac**

Rhus typhina 'Bailtiger' PP16185

Sun to Part Shade

6' tall 6' across

A beautiful golden-leaved form of cutleaf Staghorn Sumac. New growth is light green quickly turning yellow, with the fall colors ranging from yellow to intense scarlet. An excellent accent plant.

---

**Sunrise Sunset Rose**

Rosa 'Baiset'

Sun

2-3' tall 2-3' across

As the name implies, Sunrise Sunset is a stunning blend, with bright fuchsia-pink petals, blending to apricot near the center. Its dense low growing habit makes it excellent as a groundcover.

---

**Burning Embers Rose**

Rosa 'Burning Embers'

Sun

2-3' tall 3' across

Orange double flowers w/darker orange edge that cover the shrub all season long. Glossy foliage is resistant to both insects and disease.

---

**Lady Elsie May Rose**

Rosa 'Lady Elsie May'

Sun

30-36" tall 24" across

This vigorous shrub rose grows quickly into a mounded plant with lush waxy, green foliage and a profusion of coral-pink blossoms throughout the summer and fall. Excellent disease resistance.

---

**Red Drift Rose**

Rosa 'Meigalpio' PP17877

Sun

1.5' tall 2-3' across

A petite rose plant with great abundances of small red flowers with white eyes. Makes a great fill-in plant and will brighten up a dull spot in your landscape. Blooms from late spring till frost.

---

---

**Peach Drift Rose**

Rosa 'Meiggili' PP18542

Sun

1-2' tall 2-3' across

A beautiful ground cover rose with double flowers that open a dark motled peach blend and slowly turn to a light peach color.

---

**Knockout Rose**

Rosa 'Radrazz' PP11836

Sun to Part Sun

3-4' tall 3-4' across

Deep cerise buds open to blooms of cherry red backed by deep foliage tinged with burgundy. In fall, foliage takes on a deeper burgundy cast and bright orange-red hips appear. Very disease resistant.

---

**Sunny Knockout Rose**

Rosa 'Radsunny' PP18562

Sun

3-4' tall 3-4' across

Compact shrub with dark green foliage producing single, bright yellow flowers at opening, turning creamy white when fully open. Yellow color stays stronger during cooler times of the year.

---

**Double Knockout Rose**

Rosa 'Radtko' PP16202

Sun to Part Sun

3-4' tall 3-4' across

Twice the number of petals as Knockout makes this rose a big hit. Red blooms from early June to hard frost. Winter hardy and some shade tolerance.

---

**Yellow Brick Road Rose**

Rosa 'Yellow Brick Road'

Sun

2-3' tall 3' across

Compact shrub with clusters of lemon-yellow blossoms that mature to butter-cream. Use as a low hedge or groundcover. Disease resistant.

---

**Cherry Pie Shrub Rose**

Rosa x 'Cherry Pie'

Sun

2-3' tall 3-4' across

A low growing shrub type rose that blooms well all summer long. The flowers are single red with bright yellow stamens

---

**Home Run Rose**

Rosa x 'Home Run'

Sun

3-4' tall 3-4' across

This true red rose is a proven all-star. Home Run Rose has continuous blooms and top level disease resistance. Drought tolerant. It is cold hardy and requires no deadheading.

---

**Italian Ice Rose**

Rosa x 'Italian Ice'

Sun

16-24" tall 24-30" across

Italian Ice Rose's orange buds open to soft yellow flowers melting into pink blushed margins. The Peace-like color is set off by its dark green, glossy foliage. Semi-double, self-cleaning flowers

**Lemon Zest Shrub Rose**

Rosa x 'Lemon Zest'

Sun

2-3' tall 3-4' across

A shrub rose with single bright canary yellow flower that does not fade to white. It is free flowering, self cleaning and highly disease resistant.

---

**Flamingo Willow**

Salix intergra 'Flamingo'

Sun to Part Shade

4-5' tall 4-5' across

An interesting willow with the foliage emerging pink then slowly fading to green and white. Cut back hard in the spring and shear to maintain variegation. Good for wet sites.

---

**Alpine Spirea**

Spiraea japonica 'Alpina'

Sun to Part Shade

12-15" tall 2-3' across

A dwarf, compact plant with small blue-green leaves and dainty, pink, powder puff flowers. An excellent landscape plant that combines well with other plants. Prune in early spring.

---

**Little Princess Spirea**

Spiraea japonica 'Little Princess'

Sun

2-3' tall 3' across

Dwarf mounding, compact shrub with lavender-pink flowers from June to Sept. Blue-green leaves in summer changing to reddish-purple in fall. Prune in early spring. Great as a low hedge.

---

**Magic Carpet Spirea**

Spiraea japonica 'Magic Carpet'

Sun

18-24" tall 2' across

A dwarf spirea with vibrant red leaf tips above a backdrop of bright gold foliage. Add pinkish-purple flowers in summer and you have season long interest. Prune in early spring. Good low hedge.

---

**Dakota Goldcharm Spirea**

Spiraea japonica 'Mertyann'

Sun

12-15" tall 2-3' across

A dwarf, gold leafed spirea with bronze tips and bright pink flowers. An outstanding plant for the front of the border or even the perennial garden! Prune in early spring.

---

**Norman Spirea**

Spiraea japonica 'Norman'

Sun

2-3' tall 3' across

A very fine, semi-dwarf, upright mound of rosy pink flowers. Best fall color of spiraea; raspberry-purple to red foliage. Makes a great little hedge or low foundation plant. Prune in early spring.

---

**Gold Mound Spirea**

Spiraea x bumalda 'Gold Mound'

Sun

18-24" tall 2-3' across

A bushy plant with bright yellow foliage all season. Clusters of light pink flowers in June and July. Outstanding accent plant for color or contrast in a foundation planting. Prune in early spring.

---

---

**Neon Flash Spirea**

Spiraea x bumalda 'Neon Flash'

Sun

3' tall 3' across

This shrub lights up the summer landscape with neon red flower clusters. New foliage emerges with purplish tint, turns green and changes to dark burgundy in fall. Prune in early spring. Good hedge.

---

**Snow White Spirea**

Spiraea x trilobata 'Snow White'

Sun

4' tall 3-4' across

Cascading pure white flowers in April or May. Dark blue-green foliage forms a vase shaped shrub. Good shrub for hedges or shrub borders. Prune after flowering in the spring.

---

**Double Play Candy Corn Spirea**

Spiraea japonica 'NCSX1' PP28313

Sun to Part Shade

12-24" tall 12-24" across

A spirea with a sweet display of bright candy apple red foliage in early spring. The foliage matures a pineapple yellow color, contrasting with the new growth. Dark purple blooms in late spring.

---

**Hancock Coralberry**

Symphoricarpos x chenaultii 'Hancock'

Sun to Shade

24-36" tall 4-6' across

A low spreading plant that makes an excellent groundcover, bank holding shrub, or front plant in a shrub border. Numerous rose-pink berries are attractive in fall.

---

**Bloomerang Dark Purple Lilac**

Syringa 'SMSJBP7' PP19009

Sun

4-6' tall 4-6' across

A medium sized Lilac with Purple flowers in mid-spring. The bloom is heavy in spring with abundant fragrant flowers, followed in summer with a second lighter bloom.

---

**Dwarf Korean Lilac**

Syringa meyeri 'Palibin'

Sun

4-5' tall 5-7' across

A very hardy, low growing lilac with lavender colored blossoms. Very fragrant. Dense, dark green, mildew resistant foliage. Excellent foundation plant. Prune after flowering in spring.

---

**Common Purple Lilac**

Syringa vulgaris

Sun

12-15' tall 8-12' across

Old-fashioned lilac that is everyone's favorite. Lavender-purple flowers that appear in May are the most fragrant of all lilacs. Good for screens and windbreaks. Prune after flowering in spring.

---

**Declaration Lilac**

Syringa X hyacinthiflora 'Declaration'

Sun

8-10' tall 6-8' across

A plant selection from the National Arboretum. It was selected for its large, fragrant, dark reddish-purple flowers and clean foliage. With an upright growth habit. It blooms before other lilacs.

---

**Mt. Baker Lilac**

Syringa x hyacinthiflora 'Mt Baker'

Sun

8-10' tall 8-10' across

An early blooming lilac with very fragrant, pure white flowers. Mildew resistant.

---

**Royal Purple Lilac**

Syringa x hyacinthiflora 'Skinner'

Sun

8-10' tall 6-8' across

This is an early blooming hybrid with fragrant, dark purple double flowers.

---

**Anabel Lilac**

Syringa x hyacinthiflora 'Anabel'

Sun

6-8' tall 5-7' across

This lilac has fragrant fully double pink blooms in early spring. It is rated one of the best pink Lilacs. It is also one of the earliest Lilacs to bloom.

---

**Dense Yew**

Taxus x media 'Densiflora'

Shade to Part Sun

4-6' tall 4-6' across

Dark green foliage with new growth in spring. Plant on the N or E side of a structure out of the wind. Requires good drainage. Excellent for foundation plantings and hedges.

---

**Everlow Yew**

Taxus x media 'Everlow'

Shade to Part Sun

3-4' tall 3-4' across

Very low spreading yew with bright glossy green foliage. Plant on N or E side of a structure out of the wind. Requires well drained soils and very little pruning. Good for foundation plantings.

---

**Hicks Yew**

Taxus x media 'Hicksii'

Shade to Part Sun

8-10' tall 3-5' across

An upright, almost columnar growing yew that is extremely hardy. Produces bright red berries in the fall. Requires well drained soils. Plant on N or E side of a structure. Excellent hedge.

---

**Fire Chief Arborvitae**

Thuja occidentalis 'Congabe' PP19009

Sun

3-4' tall 3-4' across

A nearly perfect globe-shaped shrub with bright golden foliage and fantastic deep red fall color. A slow growing low maintenance evergreen.

---

**DeGroot's Spire Arborvitae**

Thuja occidentalis 'Degroot's Spire'

Sun

6-10' tall 3-4' across

An outstanding very narrow columnar evergreen with fine textured medium green foliage. Tolerant of extremes in temperature, moisture and soils. Great as an accent plant or as a very narrow hedge.

---

**Emerald Arborvitae**

Thuja occidentalis 'Emerald'

Sun

10-15' tall 3-5' across

Compact narrow columnar form. Bright emerald green foliage that holds its color well during the winter. Excellent heat and cold tolerance. Great as a hedge.

---

**Hetz Midget Arborvitae**

Thuja occidentalis 'Hetz Midget'

Sun to Part Shade

1-2' tall 1-2' across

A dense compact globe Arborvitae with fans of green foliage. The growth rate slows and habit becomes more squat with age. A popular dwarf variety.

---

**Woodward Globe Arborvitae**

Thuja occidentalis 'Woodwardii'

Sun to Part Shade

3-5' tall 3-5' across

The classic globe Arborvitae. This well known variety has light green foliage that turns golden brown in winter. A good foundation plant or shear-less hedge.

---

**Emerald Triumph Viburnum**

Viburnum 'Emerald Triumph'

Sun to Shade

5-6' tall 5-6' across

A compact, rounded shrub with glossy, deep emerald, green leaves. Creamy-white flowers in May are followed by red fruits turning black in late summer. Good for foundations and shrub borders.

---

**Raspberry Tart Viburnum**

Viburnum dentatum 'Rastzam'

Sun to Part Shade

4-5' tall 4-5' across

A compact shrub that will grow in a wide variety of conditions. It has white flowers in spring, bluish-black fruit in late summer, and brilliant raspberry to wine fall color.

---

**Dwarf European Cranberry Viburnum**

Viburnum opulus 'Nanum'

Sun to Part Shade

2-3' tall 2-4' across

An extremely dense, dwarf mounded shrub that requires no trimming. Blooms and fruits are rare. Beautiful fall color. Excellent foundation or low hedge.

---

**Snowball Viburnum**

Viburnum opulus 'Sterilis'

Sun

12' tall 8' across

Many clusters of large pure white snowball-like flowers cover this shrub in late spring. Bright green foliage with reddish overtones in fall. Very showy when in bloom.

---

**Summer Snowflake Viburnum**

Viburnum p. tomentosum 'Summer Snowflake'

Sun to Part Shade

4-5' tall 4-6' across

A compact Viburnum that will produce large clusters of white flowers through the late spring and summer. It has charming bright red fruit in the fall.

---

---

**Copper Ridges Viburnum**

Viburnum plicatum 'Copper Ridges'

Sun to Part Shade

5-6' tall 5-6' across

A classic Viburnum with dark green heavily ridged leaves that turn a deep red in the fall. It also has large white clusters flowers in mid-spring.

---

**Popcorn Viburnum**

Viburnum plicatum 'Popcorn'

Sun to Part Sun

4-6' tall 4-6' across

Blooms form large balls and resemble snowballs. Foliage is small and leathery, turning burgundy in the fall. Compact rounded shrub makes a great foundation, hedge, or specimen plant.

---

**Leatherleaf Viburnum**

Viburnum rhytidophyllum

Sun to Shade

10-12' tall 10-12' across

A semi-evergreen, upright shrub with clusters of white flowers in spring that later form red berries turning black as they ripen. Good specimen plant tolerant of hot, dry locations. Useful as hedge.

---

**Redwing Viburnum**

Viburnum trilobum

Sun to Part Sun

8-10' tall 6-8' across

New spring foliage is tinted a nice red color, white flowers appear in mid to late May, followed by ornamental clusters of persistent red fruit in late fall to early winter. Fall color is bright red.

---

**Pragense Viburnum**

Viburnum x 'Pragense'

Shade to Sun

8-10' tall 6-8' across

A fast-growing evergreen shrub with an upright rounded form. Pink buds open to creamy-white, delicately fragrant flowers mid to late spring. Good for screening, group plantings or as an accent.

---

**Cayuga Viburnum**

Viburnum x Cayuga

Sun to Part Shade

6-7' tall 6-7' across

A large rounded shrub with very fragrant flowers in late April and early May. The flower buds are a light pink opening into waxy white flowers. Russet-red fall color.

---

**Minuet Weigela**

Weigela florida 'Minuet'

Sun to Part Shade

24-36" tall 2-3' across

Fragrant, two-toned magenta-rose and light purple flowers bloom freely for 3 to 6 weeks. The leaves are green with a hint of red.

---

**Polka Weigela**

Weigela florida 'Polka'

Sun to Part Shade

4-6' tall 3-4' across

Large bright pink flowers cover this compact plant. Extremely long blooming period from June to September. A very hardy and desirable weigela.

---

**Red Prince Weigela**

Weigela florida 'Red Prince'

Sun to Part Shade

5-6' tall 5-6' across

An excellent weigela with abundant dark red flowers in May and June that resist fading. Has rich, dark green foliage. A hardy re-bloomer. May have second flush of blooms in late summer.

---

**Tango Weigela**

Weigela florida 'Tango'

Sun

2-3' tall 2-3' across

Tango has a compact, bushy habit with standout purple foliage. The flowers are a beautiful red with a yellow throat and contrast nicely with the foliage.

---

**Wings of Fire Weigela**

Weigela florida 'Wings of Fire'

Sun to Part Shade

3-4' tall 3-4' across

This Weigela is not a heavy flowerer, however it does have beautiful summer foliage. In summer green leaves turn red burgundy and bronze. In fall the foliage turns fiery-red. Pink blooms in spring.
