
Atomic Red Trumpet Vine

Campsis radicans 'Stromboli'
Sun to Part Shade 20-30'

A vigorous vine that will climb on stone or woodwork. Dark red buds open in summer to large orange-red trumpet like flowers that deepen to bold red.

Alpina Pink Flamingo

Clematis
Sun 10' vining BLOOMS May-July

1.5" semi-double flowers are pale pink with red veins. Remove dead material only then prune after all flowering has completed. Type 1

Asao

Clematis
Sun to Part Shade 8-10' vining BLOOMS May, June, & August
4-5" deep rosy-pink flower with white center bar. Cut all dead material above swelling buds in spring. Type 2

Bernadine

Clematis
Sun to Part Sun 4-5' tall Blooms May through Oct
Low growing, patio size w/mauve flowers. Prune in Feb & March as these clematis bloom on new growth. New buds will emerge low on plant. Type 3

Bijou

Clematis
Sun to Part Shade 1' tall BLOOMS May through July
Pale violet to mauve flowers in a lovely rosette shape. Free flowering, nice low mounding clematis. Prune type 2. Cut all dead material off above swelling buds.

Bourbon

Clematis
Sun to Part Shade 4-6' vining BLOOMS June-early August
Vibrant red flowers w/contrasting yellow anthers. Good for containers. Spring-prune dead material above swelling buds. Attach to trellis. Type 2

Candy Stripe

Clematis
Sun to Part Shade 10' vining BLOOMS May-June & August
Two toned lavender & pink striped flowers. Spring-prune dead material above swelling buds. Attach to trellis. Type 2

Cardinal Wyszynski

Clematis
Sun to Part Shade 8-10' vining BLOOMS July-Sept
Large glowing crimson flowers each highlighted by a central cluster of dark anthers. Very vigorous. Cut dead above swelling buds in spring. Type 2

Cezanne

Clematis
Sun to Part Sun 3-4' vining Blooms June through August
Sky blue single flowers w/overlapping petals & yellow anthers. Well-suited for growing in a container. Prune type 2, Cut all dead material above swelling buds in late spring.

Corinne

Clematis
Sun to Part Shade 4-6' tall Blooms spring and summer
White flower w/ruffly edge and pink stripe on each petal. In spring, cut dead material above swelling buds making sure all growth is tied loosely to trellis. Type 2

Dawn

Clematis
Sun to Part Shade 6' vining BLOOMS May-June & August
Pearly white/pink open flower. Compact and free flowering makes this one good for containers. Spring-prune dead material above swelling buds. Attach to trellis. Type 2

Diamantina

Clematis
Sun to Part Shade 7' vining BLOOMS June-early August
4-6" blue\purple, double, pom-pom like flowers. Spring-prune dead material above swelling buds. Attach to trellis. Type 2

Hagley Hybrid

Clematis
Sun 7-8' vining BLOOMS June & September
A vigorous grower and heavy bloomer that produces medium sized, light pink flowers. Prune in February or March as new leaf buds begin to show low on plant. Remove everything above these buds. Type 3

Jackmani

Clematis
Sun 9-12' Vining BLOOMS mid-late summer
Produces 4-6" velvety-purple flowers. Prune in February or March as new leaf buds begin to show low on plant. Remove everything above these buds. Type 3

Jackmani Superba

Clematis
Sun 8' vining BLOOMS mid-late summer
Produces 4-6" velvety-purple flowers, more rounded than traditional Jackman. Prune in February or March as new leaf buds begin to show low on plant. Remove everything above these buds. Type 3

John Huxtable

Clematis
Sun 9-12' Vining BLOOMS mid-late summer
Produces 6" creamy white flowers. Prune in February or March as new leaf buds begin to show low on plant. Remove everything above these buds. Type 3

Josephine

Clematis
Sun 8' vining BLOOMS June- August
Flowers have 6-8 base petals which are bronze, w/green & dark bar. Inner petals lilac w/pink bar. Spring-prune dead material above swelling buds. Attach to trellis. Type 2

Miss Bateman

Clematis
Sun to Part Sun 10' tall Blooms May, June & Sept
Round, white flower w/dark showy anthers. In early spring, cut dead material above swelling buds. Make sure all growth is tied loosely to trellis. Type 2

Mme Baron Veillard

Clematis
Sun to Part Sun 10-12' tall Blooms June & Sept
Large, 7-8" bluish-pink flower, makes this clematis very showy. Prune in Feb and March as these clematis bloom on new growth. New buds will everge low on plant. Type 3

Nelly Mosier

Clematis
Part Sun to Shade Vines 8-12' long BLOOMS May, June, Aug & Sept
Produces 7-9" pale pink blooms with a red bar down the middle of each sepal. Prune in February or March as new leaf buds begin to show low on plant. Type 2

Niobe

Clematis
Sun to Part Shade 6-8' vining BLOOMS June, August, September
Dark red pointed petals w/gold anthers. Spring-prune dead material above swelling buds. Attach to trellis. Type 2

Paniculata Sweet Autumn

Clematis
Sun 10-20' vining BLOOMS Aug - Sept.
Very vigorous vine producing clusters of 1/2", fragrant, white flowers. Prune right after all flowering has been completed. Prune all dead and weak stems after flowering. Type 3

Perle D'Azur

Clematis
Sun 12' vining BLOOMS mid-late summer
True blue flowers w/pale yellow anthers. Prune in February or March as new leaf buds begin to show low on plant. Remove everything above these buds. Type 3

Picardy

Clematis
Sun to Part Shade 4' vining BLOOMS June- August
Red/Purple flowers w/brown anthers. Spring-prune dead material above swelling buds. Attach to trellis. Type 2

Ramona

Clematis
Sun to Part Shade 10-16' vining BLOOMS July-Sept
Lavender-blue flowers w/dark anthers. Spring-prune dead material above swelling buds. Attach to trellis. Type 2

Rebecca

Clematis
Sun 6-8' vining BLOOMS May-June, August
Large red flowers w/creamy yellow anthers. Spring-prune dead material above swelling buds. Attach to trellis. Type 2

Rosemoor

Clematis
Sun 10' vining BLOOMS May-September
Redish-purple flowers w/yellow anthers. Prune in February or March as new leaf buds begin to show low on plant. Remove everything above these buds. Type 3

The President

Clematis
Sun to Part Sun 8-12' vining Blooms May-June and Sept-Oct
Deep purple w/purple anthers. Large 7-8" flowers June & Sept. Prune type 2, Prune all dead material above swelling buds in late spring.

Triterinata Rubromarginata

Clematis
Sun 10-13' vining BLOOMS July-September
Pink star-like flowers. Prune in February or March as new leaf buds begin to show low on plant. Remove everything above these buds. Type 3

Vyvyan Pennell

Clematis
Sun to Part Shade 8' vining BLOOMS June- August
Purple-mauve, double flowers. Spring-prune dead material above swelling buds. Attach to trellis. Type 2

Wintercreeper Euonymus

Euonymus fortunei 'Coloratus'
Sun to Shade 6-10" tall Space 12" apart
Ivy-like growth makes an outstanding evergreen ground cover. Deep green foliage turns beautiful, rich plum color during the cool season. Will climb nearby structures or walls. Moderate Foot Traffic

Chameleon Houttuynia

Houttuynia cordata
Sun to Part Sun 6-9" tall Space 6-9" apart
A quick spreading, perennial ground cover with erect stems holding heart-shaped, multi-colored leaves of gray-green, cream, carmine and gold. Keep moist, will grow in water.

Cascade Hops

Humulus lupulus 'Cascade'
Sun to Part Shade 12-15' tall
The hop for craft brews. Used for flavor and aroma. Dark green foliage and fragrant large elongated cone flowers with a floral aroma and spicy citrus grapefruit like-notes. Flowers late summer.

Gold Lamium

Lamium maculatum 'Aureum'
Shade to Part Shade 6" tall Space 12-15" apart
Flowers lavender-pink in spring to summer. All gold leaf with white center. Good contrast plant in containers and landscape.

White Nancy Lamium

Lamium spp.
Shade 6" tall Space 12" apart
An excellent ground cover plant with heavy variegation. Leaves are silvery gray with a green margin and lavender-pink flowers.

Everlasting Sweet Pea

Lathyrus latifolius 'Pearl Mixture'
Sun Vine 6'+ BLOOMS Summer - Fall
A vigorous vine with Pea-like foliage producing a mix of red, rose and white flowers. For best display of flowers, some sort of trellis or support will need to be provided for the vine to grow on.

Purpleleaf Honeysuckle

Lonicera japonica var. purpurea
Sun to Shade 15-30' vine Space 2-3' apart
Sprawling grower has vine-like stems displaying green leaves tinted purple underneath. Fragrant yellow flowers with white insides attractive to hummingbirds in summer. Vigorous ground cover. MFT

Goldflame Honeysuckle

Lonicera x heckrottii
Sun 10-20' long vine
A hardy and everblooming vine that produces large flame-coral trumpets lined with gold. Best used on a trellis or fence.

Japanese Pachysandra

Pachysandra terminalis
Shade to Part Shade 4-6" tall 6-9" apart
An excellent ground cover for small shady areas. This selection has attractive stems that hold extremely glossy, bright green leaves.

Silver Lace Vine

Polygonum Aubertii
Part Sun to Shade Vines 20-30' long BLOOMS Summer & Fall
An extremely fast growing vine that produces profuse fragrant white flowers in late summer and fall. Great for growing on fences and masonry walls.

Sunray Sedum

Sedum Kamschaticum 'Sunray'

Sun to Part Shade 6" tall Space 9-12" apart

Excellent ground cover for banks or dry sunny areas. Green foliage stays nice all season. Produces clusters of lemon yellow flowers. Tolerates moisture partial shade better than other sedums. LFT

Dragons Blood Sedum

Sedum spurium 'Dragons blood'

Sun 1-2" tall Space 6-9" apart

This selection has bronze-red foliage that keeps its color all season long. Rose-red flowers appear on short stalks above the foliage. Light Foot Traffic

Silver Thyme

Thyme Argeteus

Sun to Part Shade 6-12" tall Space 12" apart

Forms a mound of delicate, silver-edged foliage that becomes adorned w/pale lavender flowers in spring & summer.

Doone Valley Thyme

Thymus citriodorus

Sun to Part Sun 2-3" tall Space 6-8" apart

Perennial herb with small yellow flecked, lemon scented foliage. Light, purple flowers. Nice groundcover. Leaves and blossoms are used as brilliantly colored, fragrant garnish. Moderate foot traffic.

Vinca

Vinca Minor

Shade 6" tall Space 6-9" apart

One of the best groundcovers for shade, displaying shiny, dense luxuriant foliage. To enhance the spectacular foliage are pale lavender-blue flowers in spring. Moderate foot traffic.

Cooke's Purple Wisteria

Wisteria sinensis 'Cooke's purple'

Sun Vining 10' per season

Impressive show of large, fragrant, purple blossoms on long racemes covering vines in early spring. Will also rebloom sporadically throughout the summer.
