**Asparagus**

Purple Passion  
Sun

Mid April-June of next year  
6-8" apart in rows 4-5' apart

Sweeter and more tender than green varieties, with beautiful, purple spears. A colorful addition to your salad. Spears turn green when cooked.

---

**Asparagus**

UC 157

Mid April-June of next year  
12-15" apart in rows 4-5' apart

Hybrid w/heat tolerance and high productivity. Plant from mid-March to April. Thrives best in soils high in organic matter.

---

**Blackberry**

Chester Thornless Blackberry  
Sun

Space 4-10' apart

A heavy yielding, semi-erect, thornless variety with medium to large fruit and honey-sweet flavor. Tolerates heat and grows to about 5'-6' tall. Great for pies, jams, or just fresh eating.

**Blueberry**

Kabluey Blueberry  
Sun

Space 5' apart

A large vigorous shrub that produces heavy crops of medium size blueberries. The foliage is glossy green in summer and turns fiery red in fall. Needs acidic soil.

---

**Blueberry**

Northblue Blueberry  
Sun

Space 5' apart

The fruit is dark blue, large, with excellent flavor. The plant has glossy green leaves and will do well as a landscape plant. Grows 20" tall. Needs acidic soil.

**Blueberry**

Patriot Blueberry  
Sun

Space 5' apart

Fruit is very large and firm with excellent flavor. This shrub is upright, open, and vigorous. Has white flowers in spring, dark foliage in summer, and fiery orange fall color. Needs acidic soil.

**Broccoli**

Destiny  
Sun

Harvest 55-65 days from transplant  
Space 18" apart in rows 36" apart

Heads above plant so easy to harvest. Second crop of side shoots produced after cutting main head. Grow early spring or fall after temps begin to drop.

**Bush Bean**

Blue Lake

Harvest 58 days from transplant  
Space 4" apart in rows 24" apart

Produces long, fully rounded pods. White seeds are slow to develop. Produces heavy crops over a long season.

**Cabbage**

Ruby Perfection

Harvest 76 days from transplant  
Space 18" apart in rows 36" apart

Early to mid season cabbage producing approximately 3 pound, round, tight heads that are red in color.

---

**Cabbage**

Stonehead

Harvest 60-70 days from transplant  
Space 18" apart in rows 36" apart

Early to mid season cabbage producing solid 3-1/2 pound heads. Nice blue-green in color. Yellows resistant. "AAS Winner!"

---

**Cauliflower**

Snow Crown

Harvest 50-55 days from transplant  
Space 18" apart in rows 36" apart

Produces 2-1/2 pound pure white heads. Cover heads as they mature to blanch them white. Tastes excellent fresh or frozen. "AAS Winner!"

---

**Cucumber**

Burpless 26

Harvest 62 days from transplant  
Space 10-12" apart

Vines produce 9" long, straight, dark green fruit. Best if grown on a trellis to achieve nice, straight fruit.

**Cucumber**

Bush Pickle

Harvest 48 days from transplant  
Compact habit

Vines produce 4-5" cylindrical fruits on bushy, compact plants. Perfect for small gardens or patio planters.

---

**Cucumber**

Fanfare

Harvest 63 days from transplant  
Compact vine

Compact growing vines produce well-flavored, uniform, slender, dark-green fruit. Averaging in length of 8-9" long.

---

**Eggplant**

Black Beauty

Harvest 80 days from transplant  
Space 18-30" apart in rows 30" apart

Firm, 8" oval, purple fruit. Should yield 10-12 fruits per compact plant.

---

**Eggplant**

Japanese Millionaire

Harvest 65 days from transplant  
Space 30-36" apart in rows 30" apart

Oriental type of eggplant that produces long, slender, deep purple fruit with creamy white flesh. Subtle flavor and thin skinned.

---

**Gooseberry**

Pixwell Gooseberry  
Sun

Space 3' apart

A small shrub producing pale-pink fruit. Very productive, self-pollinating, and bears the first year. Plants are nearly thorn-free and do well in average soils. Makes the best berry pies!

---

**Grape**

Canadice Seedless Grape

Sun

Space 3' apart

Fully ripe red grapes are firm and have a pleasant tang, no tough skins. Flavor is excellent! This variety is hard to beat for fresh use. Produces 35-40 clusters of fruit per vine. Seedless.

**Grape**

Concord Seedless Grape

Sun

Space 3' apart

Prolific vines producing large seedless grapes that are excellent for desserts, wine or juice. Train on a sturdy garden fence or trellis.

---

**Grape**

Edelweiss Grape

Sun

Space 3' apart

A vigorous green-white grape with high sugar content and a good taste. This is a very disease resistant variety. A good dessert and wine grape.

---

**Kale**

Dinosaur

Sun

Harvest 30-60 days after transplanting

Space 24"-36" apart

An Italian heirloom w/ blue-green leaves, loaded w/flavor. Harvest young in the spring but after the first frost as a fall crop.

---

**Kohlrabi**

Winner

Harvest 45 days from transplant

Space 3" apart in rows 18-24" apart

Very flavorful, reaches 4" diameter without becoming woody. Cross between turnip & cabbage.

---

**Leek**

American Flag

Harvest 70-100 days from transplant

Space 4-6" apart in rows 18" apart

Stalks have delicious mild onion flavor. Plant in trenches and mound soil up as they grow to promote blanching of the stalks. Very cold tolerant.

---

**Lettuce**

Butter crunch

Harvest 64-75 days from transplant

Space 6-8" apart in rows 18" apart

Butter head type of lettuce with thick flavorful, dark green leaves. Plants tend to be heat tolerant. Slower to bolt than most bibb lettuces. Virus resistant.

---

**Lettuce**

Great Lakes 659

Harvest 80-90 days from transplant

Space 12" apart in rows 18" apart

Excellent heading lettuce that produces large, firm, crisp, tender, fresh heads that are tasty in salads.

---

**Muskmelon**

Ball 2076 F1

Harvest 78 days from transplant

Space hills 36 to 48" apart

Very sweet flavor; thick, 5 lb fruit w/orange flesh; heavy netting. Disease resistant.

---

**Okra**

Compact Green Fingers

Harvest 45-50 days after transplant into warm soil

Space 18" apart in rows 36" apart

Produces dark green succulent 4" pods on compact, bushy plant. Attractive foliage w/pastel yellow flowers, ideal for container. Thrives and requires lots of Kansas heat.

**Okra**

Jambalaya

Harvest 50-55 days after transplant into warm soil

Space 18" apart in rows 36" apart

Produces dark green succulent 4-5" pods on compact plant. Thrives and requires lots of Kansas heat.

---

**Onion**

Candy

Harvest 85 days

Space dependant on use

Day neutral variety. Huge, extremely early bulbs have golden brown skin and white interiors with a sweet, mild flavor.

---

**Pepper**

Anaheim Chili

Harvest 75-80 days from transplant

Space 18-24" apart in rows 24-36" apart

Tapered dark green to red pepper, bear throughout the season. Mildly hot.

---

**Pepper**

Baron

Harvest 72-75 days from transplant

Space 18-24" apart in rows 24-36" apart

Upright growing pepper producing thick walled, 4-lobed, 4" long fruit, sweet tasting, red/green fruits. Excellent for eating fresh, roasting & stuffing.

---

**Pepper**

California Wonder

Harvest 75 days

Space 18-24" apart

Upright growing pepper producing 4x4", 4-lobed blocky fruit. TVM resistant. Fruits remain green maturing to red.

---

**Pepper**

Garden Salsa

Harvest 73 day from transplant

Space 18-24" apart in rows 24-36" apart

Upright growing pepper plant producing 1x8-9", dark green fruit maturing to red. Moderately hot, ideal for salsa.

---

**Pepper**

Golden Bell

Harvest 65 days from transplant

Space 18-24" apart in rows 24-36" apart

Upright growing pepper with golden, blocky, thick walled, 3-1/2 x 4" fruit. Sweet green fruits mature to deep golden color.

**Pepper**

Habanero

Harvest 95 days from transplant

Compact and bushy

1-1/2 x 1" light green, orange. The hottest pepper in our greenhouse. Space 18-24" apart in rows 24-36" apart.

**Pepper**

Jalapeno  
Harvest 60-65 days from transplant  
Space 18-24" apart in rows 24-36" apart  
Upright growing pepper plant that produces 2-1/2 x 1" medium green fruit that matures to a bright red. Very HOT and PUNGENT!

---

**Pepper**

Long Red Cayenne-F1  
Harvest 70 days from transplant  
Space 18-24" apart in rows 24-36" apart  
Upright growing pepper producing 4-1/2 x 3/4" long, thin, green fruit. Fruit turns red at maturity. EXTREMELY HOT!

---

**Pepper**

Sweet Banana  
Harvest 65-70 days from transplant  
Space 18-24" apart in rows 24-36" apart  
Upright growing pepper producing 6x1-1/4", waxy, yellow fruit that taper to point. Sweet green fruits mature to deep golden color.

---

**Raspberry**

Bristol Black Raspberry  
Sun  
Space 3' apart  
Large black fruit with attractive glossy skin. Flesh is firm, excellent quality and good flavor. Good for canning or freezing.

---

**Raspberry**

Killarney Raspberry  
Sun  
Space 3' apart  
A summer-bearing red raspberry with great aroma and flavor. Excellent for freezing and canning. Sturdy growth habit. A distinct improvement over Latham.

---

**Rheum x 'Crimson Cherry'**

Crimson Cherry Rhubarb  
Sun  
3' tall  
An excellent variety with long, thick, bright red stalks that are very tender and sweet.

---

**Rheum x 'Victoria'**

Victoria Rhubarb  
Sun  
Space 2-3' apart  
Medium sized stalks that vary in color from green to speckled red. Excellent flavor, but somewhat tart. A good producer.

---

**Spinach**

Seaside  
Sun  
Harvest 25 days from transplant  
Space 6" apart in rows 15" apart  
Slow-bolting, smooth-leaved variety for spring and summer. Seaside has upright, dark green leaves; stays small, which extends the baby leaf harvest window.

---

**Squash-Summer**

Gold Crookneck  
Harvest 50 days from transplant.  
Space 2 per hill, 5-10' apart  
Bush-like vine producing heavy yields of slightly warted, bright yellow fruit. Fine texture and flavor.

---

**Squash-Summer**

Zucchini Hybrid  
Harvest 48-54 days from transplant  
Space hills 3-6' apart  
Heavy producer of dark green, straight, 6-8" long fruit.

---

**Squash-Winter**

Butterbush  
Harvest 85 days from transplant  
Space 3' apart  
Produces 1-1/2 to 1-3/4 LB deep reddish-orange fruit. Has a very delicious, sweet, buttery flavor.

---

**Squash-Winter**

Table Ace F1  
Harvest 70 days from transplant  
Space 4' apart  
Produces 5-6" long, acorn type, dark green fruit with golden yellow flesh. Good winter squash with a nutty flavor.

---

**Strawberry**

Allstar  
Sun  
June Bearing  
Space 12-18" apart  
As the name implies - the best of the best. It has excellent flavor, high yields and large fruit size. Excellent variety for the home garden.

**Strawberry**

Eversweet  
Sun  
Everbearing  
Space 12-18" apart  
Large red berries with exceptional flavor. Produces fruit all summer long. Very heat tolerant. Great for patio planters.

---

**Strawberry**

Ozark Beauty  
Sun  
Everbearing  
Space 12-18" apart  
Sets lots of large delicious berries with sugar-sweet taste and juicy texture. Withstands leaf spot and leaf scorch.

---

**Strawberry**

Temptation  
Everbearing  
Space 12-18" apart in rows 12-18" apart  
Delicious ever-bearing alpine strawberry that bears good sized deep red fruit in the first season. Vigorous compact growth makes it ideally suited for hanging baskets or patio containers.

**Sweet Potato**

Vardaman  
Harvest 90-100 day from transplant  
Set 1' apart in ridges or rows 3.5' apart  
Produces delicious tasting, golden yellow tubers with deep orange flesh. Idea for small gardens. Yields are excellent. A USDA release. Ideal pH is 5.8-6.0; use dolomitic lime to raise pH if needed.

**Tomatilla**

Grande Rio Verde  
 Sun  
 Harvest 70 days from transplant  
 Space 2-3' apart in rows 3-4' apart  
 Need 2 plants to insure pollination, plant produces heavy yields of 3 oz green tomatillos for salsa verde. Tomatillos are fully ripe when it falls from plant.

**Tomato**

Beefmaster  
 Sun  
 Harvest 70 days from transplant  
 Space 2-3' apart in rows 3-4' apart  
 Indeterminate growing tomato producing extra large, round shaped fruit up to 12 oz or more in weight. VFN resistant.

**Tomato**

Better Boy  
 Harvest 70 days from transplant  
 Space 24-36" apart in rows 36-48" apart  
 Indeterminate growing tomato producing large, 12-16 oz, globe shaped fruit. Produces heavy yields. VFN resistant.

**Tomato**

Big Boy  
 Harvest 78 days from transplant  
 Space 24-36" apart in rows 36-48" apart  
 A mid season, indeterminate growing tomato producing large, 12-16 oz, globe shaped fruit.

**Tomato**

Brandywine Red  
 Harvest 75-80 days from transplant  
 Space 18" apart in rows 36" apart  
 Heirloom. Flat, globe tomatoes have reddish-pink skin and tasty red flesh. Higher yielding in cooler weather. 10-16oz fruit size.

**Tomato**

Celebrity  
 Harvest 70 days from transplant  
 Space 24-36" apart in rows 36-48" apart  
 Determinate growing tomato with large, glossy, fruit with light green shoulders. VFR 1 & 2 NT resistant.

**Tomato**

Early Girl Improved  
 Harvest 52-54 days from transplant  
 Space 24-36" apart in rows 36-48" apart  
 Indeterminate growing tomato producing 4-6 oz. round fruit. Earliest slicing tomato. VF Race 1 & 2 resistant.

**Tomato**

German Johnson  
 Harvest 80 days from transplant  
 Space 24-36" apart in rows 36-48" apart  
 Indeterminate growing tomato producing extra large fruit up to 16 oz. or more in weight; sweet flavor. Heirloom variety worth a try if you have never grown them before.

**Tomato**

Jet Star  
 Harvest 72 days from transplant  
 Space 24-36" apart in rows 36-48" apart  
 Indeterminate growing tomato with medium globe shaped fruit. Resistant to VFR 1.

**Tomato**

Juliet  
 Harvest 60 days from transplant  
 Space 24-36" apart to 36-48" apart  
 Indeterminate growing tomato producing sweet, oblong shaped fruit that resist cracking and hold well on vine. Excellent for salads.

**Tomato**

La Roma  
 Harvest 76 days from transplant  
 Space 24-36" apart in rows 36-48" apart  
 Determinate growing tomato with large plum to pear shaped fruit. Good for salads, sauces and canning. Resistant to V F1 N and bacterial speck.

**Tomato**

Lemon Boy  
 Harvest 80 days from transplant  
 Space 24-36" apart in rows 36-48" apart  
 Indeterminate growing tomato producing excellent 8-9 oz, yellow fruit with low acid and mild flavor.

**Tomato**

Red Cherry  
 Harvest 75 days from transplant  
 Space 24-36" apart in rows 36-48" apart  
 Indeterminate growing tomato producing round 1-1/4" red fruit. A very heavy producer. Great for fresh garden salads and garnish.

**Tomato**

Red Grape  
 Sun  
 Harvest 65 days from transplant  
 Space 24-36" apart in rows 36-48" apart  
 A consistent top choice in taste tests, w/ a higher sugar content than any other grape tomato. Indeterminate type

**Tomato**

Rutgers  
 Harvest 76-82 days from transplant  
 Space 24-36" in rows 36-48" apart  
 Indeterminate growing tomato with medium sized, flattened, globe-shaped fruits that are resistant to cracking. Resistant to V F race 1.

**Tomato**

Sweet 100  
 Harvest 65 days from transplant  
 Space 24-36" apart to 36-48" apart  
 Indeterminate growing tomato producing clusters of smooth, red, 1 to 1-1/2" fruit. Combines the sweetest flavor with exceptional disease resistance.

**Tomato**

Sweet N Neat F1  
 Harvest 90 days from transplant  
 Space 24-36" apart to 36-48" apart  
 These tomato plants are small in size but big in taste. Each plant produces over 15 ripe fruit on an 8" plant, great for instant container gardening.

**Tomato**

Yellow Pear

Harvest 75 days from transplant

Space 24-36" apart in rows 36-48" apart

Indeterminate growing tomato that produces clear yellow pear shaped fruit that are low in acid. Individual fruits weigh less than 1 oz. each. A very productive plant.

**Watermelon**

Crimson Sweet

Harvest 97 days from transplant

Sprawling, space hills 10' apart

Dependable producer with light green rinds marked with darker green stripes. Flesh is colorful, firm and fine grained, with small seeds and a high sugar content. Resists fusarium wilt.
